ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

The competition is open to all, entry fees are:

- £25 non-RIAS members
- £20 RIAS members
- £10 students

Entry to the competition can be made through the following website: www.gia.org.uk/hamiltonmausoleum. A unique entry number will be allocated on payment of entry fee.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Your submission should contain:

- 3-6 sheets to suit screen aspect ratio 4:3, these can include a variety of sketches and images to explain your idea but must include a section, site plan and 3D representation.
- Up to 1000 words explanation of concept.

All entries to be digital, maximum individual file size 5MB. Submissions must be anonymous, your unique number allocated on payment of entry fee, should be used when uploading your submission.

Due to current travel restrictions, a formal site visit will not be arranged but a full set of site information is available to all entrants and can be downloaded on receipt of entry fee. This information pack includes:

This will be a public presentation held on Zoom, with each shortlisted entry giving a 5minute presentation to the judging panel summarising the key ideas of their entry.
